VA Hosts Veterans Enrollment Event at Cumberland Clinic

The Martinsburg Veterans Affairs (VA) Medical Center's Cumberland Community-Based Outpatient Clinic is hosting a special open enrollment event for Veterans who do not currently receive health care services in the Veterans Health Administration system.

Veterans are asked to bring their military service discharge papers (DD Form 214), along with a copy of last year's tax information if available.
