Martinsburg VA Holds Public Hearing

The Martinsburg VA Medical Center will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, January 26 at 5:30 p.m. at the Post Theatre, Building 317, 510 Butler Avenue, Martinsburg, West Virginia 25405. The VA wishes to enter into a long-term lease (up to 75 years) of approximately 3.3 acres at the medical center, for a selected Lessee's development and operation of a transitional supportive housing facility, which will serve homeless Veterans on a priority basis. The parcel sits on the northwestern area of the campus, adjacent to the west employee entrance. The public is invited to attend the hearing.
