VA Hosts Ground Breaking for Fort Detrick CBOC Senator Cardin to Attend

On Friday, October 2, at 1 p.m. the VA Medical Center in Martinsburg WV will host a Ground Breaking Ceremony of its seventh Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC) at Fort Detrick, Maryland.

This new 14,500 square foot facility will improve access to VA health care for Veterans in Frederick, Maryland and the surrounding areas. The services provided will include Primary Care, Mental Health and three specialty clinics: Audiology, Orthopedics and Podiatry. Additionally, classrooms will be provided for nutrition counseling and patient education.

All visitors must enter Fort Detrick through the 7th Street entrance. Please be advised that all vehicles will be searched and all visitors must present a valid picture I.D.

Please keep in mind this is an active construction site. Appropriate shoes are suggested.
