Thank you for thinking of the Martinsburg VA Medical Center when it comes to your donation! Listed below are the items we currently need to meet the special needs of our Veterans:

Gas cards - We do have Veterans who make it to the VA for appointments but are in need of gas just to get them back home, not much but at least \$10 to fill the tank to get home.

Lotion - Veteran inpatients are in much need of lotion for their skin, especially in the winter months.

Liquid bath soap - Very much needed, consistently!

Deodorant - Both men and women

Disposable razors - Triple blade or higher (if possible)

Shaving cream - Sensitive Skin

Socks and Underwear - Both men and women

T-shirts - Men

Hair brushes and combs - Both men and women

Postage Stamps - Veterans do come to Voluntary Service for a stamp or two to mail out letters and cards to family and friends and sometimes have important documents that need to be sent to entities to obtain records. The "Forever Stamps" are the best.

Adult coloring books, colored pencils and sharpeners

Notebooks/Journals - These have been requested by many Veteran inpatients.
